Like the original, you can choose the best character for each level – Mario, Luigi, Toad, and Princess Peach. Each one gives you a different advantage, which can really help get you through the game. But for some reason or other, I usually stick with Mario. Occasionally I'll switch it up and pick the Princess, but I guess I'm just a creature of habit.

Mario and company have also been given some fun voices which they didn't have in the original. You might love hearing Mario repeat the same things over and over for the length of the game, or you might just want to turn your sound off. Personally, it doesn't bother me when I'm really into the game, but it does bother those around me. So if you don't want mom or dad to lose it on you while you're engrossed in your game, you might want to kill the sound!

A bonus to this cart is it comes with another game – Classic Mario Bros. This remake of Classic Mario Bros. is pretty much like the original. You pretty much knock out your enemies to make it to the next level. You can connect with other players and get a super intense game going, but I've never gotten all that excited about this game. It is much more fun when you've got someone else to play with, though.
